



## *Policy for College Level Examination Program (CLEP)*

The College-Level Examination Program enables matriculated students to earn college credit by passing examinations for knowledge acquired through formal study, private reading, employment experience, non-credit courses, adult classes, TV/radio/cassette courses, and military/industrial/business training.

CLEP offers two types of tests. The General Examinations measure college-level achievement in five basic areas of Liberal Arts: English Composition, humanities, mathematics, natural science, and social sciences & history. The Subject Examinations measure achievement in specific college courses and stress concepts, principles, and relationships.

CLEP course credit will be reported on the college transcript under Transfer Course as “CL” and will not be used in computing the student’s G.P.A.
