Academic programs at Camden County College are among the most diverse and comprehensive in the country. Transfer programs prepare students for entry into a wide variety of baccalaureate programs. Career programs prepare students for entering the work place immediately after graduation.

The terms 'transfer' and 'career' simply describe the primary objective of the program. Students in transfer programs have successfully gained employment following graduation and graduates of career programs have successfully transferred to four-year colleges or universities with many of their Camden County College credits being accepted.

In general, the average degree program requires 64-66 credits for graduation. Degrees in some career professions may require additional credits.

GENERAL EDUCATION

Camden County College is committed to promoting intellectual development, aesthetic appreciation and cultural awareness. To that end, degree programs include a general education component. This component, offering choices among a variety of courses, focuses on reading analytically, communicating ideas clearly and solving essential mathematical problems. It is designed to ensure that students develop a broad base of knowledge and become proficient in the application of skills. At Camden County College, students have the opportunity to develop analytical, creative and evaluative thinking; scientific reasoning; artistic response and expression; historical consciousness; cultural awareness and sensitivity to the world around them.

Career Programs

Career Programs (A.A.S.) prepare students for entry-level employment in an occupation, which requires both theoretical knowledge and practical skills.

Transfer Programs

Transfer degree programs (A.A., A.S.) are designed primarily to enable students to enter the third year of baccalaureate study at four-year colleges and universities. Students who do not have the appropriate prerequisites may enroll in preparatory courses at the College.

Certificate Programs

Camden County College offers a number of certificate programs that provide training for specialized occupations. These certificates fall into two categories: Certificates of Achievement (CA) and Academic Certificates (CT). Academic Certificates include between 30 and 36 credits inclusive of six credits in general education (ENG 101 and a second general education course). Academic Certificates may have additional credits if there is an accrediting agency requirement that must be met.

Certificates of Achievement have less than 30 credits or more than 36 credits and do not have a general education requirement.

Preparatory Programs

Preparatory programs (Academic Skills and ESL) are designed for students who must complete specific preparatory courses or prerequisites. Students completing courses in these areas move on to regular college courses.
