## CISCO Certified Entry Networking Technician (CCENT)

The Cisco CCENT certification validates the skills required for entry-level network support positions, the starting point for many successful careers in networking. Candidates should have the knowledge and skill to install, operate and trouble-shoot a small enterprise branch network, including basic network security. CCENT certification is the first step toward achieving CCNA, which covers medium size enterprise branch networks with more complex connections. This course, in particular, is really for a person who is either getting trained to enter their first job, like a network operations job, or is assisting another CCNA to configure a small network.

### Prerequisite:

Students need to have basic computer knowledge that includes the ability to use a mouse, edit and save files. File copying, disk copying, moving and renaming directories in a Windows environment are essential. Network+ Certification is an excellent prerequisite for this program.

## CISCO Certified Entry Networking Technician/CISCO Certified Network Associate (CCENT/CCNA)

Cisco sees CCNA as its flagship curriculum, so it wants to be sure it's in step with technological advances as they occur. In light of this, the CCNA curriculum has been revised to include more networking topics and focus on performance-based skills. The Cisco CCNA network associate certification validates the ability to install, configure, operate, and troubleshoot medium-size routed and switched networks, including implementation and verification of connections to remote sites in a WAN. This new curriculum includes basic mitigation of security threats, introduction to wireless networking concepts and terminology, and performance-based skills.
