Class scheduling times are flexible and can be delivered on-site at the company location or any one of our three campus locations: Blackwood, Camden and Cherry Hill.

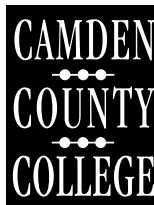

REGISTRATION GUIDELINES

Courses are offered at no cost to the employee. However, employees must be paid by the employer (at their usual hourly rate) for 25% of their attendance time in each ESL course. Total course instruction time spans 40 hours.

Eligible employees are required to provide a social security number and complete a pre-assessment placement test (provided by the College) prior to registration.

Eligible employees are required to fully attend each class session. Class times offered follow the College's credit and non-credit publicly scheduled programs.
