

Motorcycle Safety

Basic Rider Course

A great way to get started in motorcycling! Come out and try riding without buying your own motorcycle. If you can balance a bicycle, and are healthy we can probably teach you to ride a motorcycle. Our instructors have taught thousands of riders, are avid riders and have years of riding experience. Late model motorcycles of 125-250cc will be provided for each student, and students may qualify for the MVC road test waiver. The course is delivered on a closed course in a low stress environment and includes both classroom and riding instruction.

You will learn basic motorcycle control skills, defensive driving and advance turning and braking skills. In order to successfully complete the course, students must be on time and attend all sessions, pass a written test on Saturday afternoon, and pass a road test on Sunday. It is rare, but Rider Coaches reserve the right to remove any rider who cannot successfully complete the objective of the exercises in a manner that is safe for all participants. The course will run rain or shine so be prepared to ride.

This 15-hour course is offered through a partnership of Rider Training of New Jersey and Camden County College. The course consists of approximately 10-hours of riding and 5-hours of classroom. Students who successfully complete the course may qualify for a MVC road test waiver. There is no guarantee that students will qualify for the waiver, and receive a motorcycle endorsement. Students must be on time and complete all sessions, pass a written test, and a riding evaluation.

Classes are offered weekends and weekdays in the summer.

Important Notes:

Student must possess a valid motorcycle permit. This is a STATE LAW and there will be no exceptions. You must have successfully completed the MVC knowledge and eye test prior to the course date, and the permit must still be valid on the final day of class. Riders under 18 must have parental consent. You must have the ability to ride a bicycle. You must be in reasonably good health. The course is physically demanding. Students are NOT guaranteed to pass. Any changes must be made a minimum of 5 days before the day of the first class. Thereafter, no refunds are given unless a class is cancelled. Absence or tardiness from any portion of the class will result in the disqualification from the remainder of the course without refund. Prompt, 100% attendance is mandatory for successful completion. Students must have taken the written and eye test at DMV and permits must be valid until the final day of the course. Classes are conducted in the rain and require appropriate attire. Instructors reserve the right to remove a student from the riding portion of the course at any time (without refund) for the safety of all involved. Students with a "GDL" or "Z" restriction license are not eligible to receive the license waiver. Students with a "GDL" or "Z" restriction license are not eligible to receive the license waiver.

Experienced Rider Course

Have you been riding many years but never had any training, or been riding only a few months and need more confidence? Then the ERC is the course for you. Bring your own bike and gear and get ready for advanced training in overall motorcycle control, stopping, turning, swerving and defensive driving. This 6-7 hour course is taught on a closed course in a low stress environment. The course may qualify you for a defensive driving insurance discount, and may result in a 2-point reduction in MVC points.

Before signing up for the course, you should be familiar and comfortable with your motorcycle. Call us for a special class for your riding club. Get 12 riders together and we will run a class just for your group. For an additional charge, passengers may also come along for the ride.

Students will not be permitted to ride without proper gear.

- Boots-over the ankle, leather
- Long pants of heavy fabric
- Long sleeve jacket or shirt
- Full fingered gloves
- DOT Approved helmets
- DOT eye protection
- Rain gear - classes run rain or shine
- Must provide your own snacks, drinks, and lunch
