

AAG – RETURN OF FUNDS INFORMATION

If you received any combination of F, W, XA, NA the R2T4 calculation will apply. All federal aid will be reduced by 50%. If you can document in a letter from the faculty that the F's are earned aid may be reinstated. You are responsible for 100% of the tuition charge, any stipend, as well as any amounts you purchased with your book allowance.
