



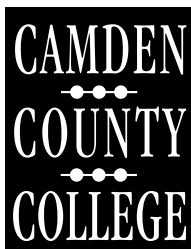

## Priority Registration Highlights

Priority Registration, offered **exclusively to our current students\* who register online via WebAdvisor**, provides every advantage to you:

- **First choice of classes!**
- **Convenience!**
- **No money up front!**

\*Your college account balance must be paid in full. Students requesting a Tuition Waiver may not register during Priority Registration. All students are required to complete an admissions application, if not already submitted. Prerequisites and placement test results must be posted to your record. Students on Academic Probation will not be permitted to use online registration.

**IMPORTANT!!!** If you plan to register for courses for which prerequisites were taken at another college, you must have an official transcript sent to Camden County College and evaluated. If you have submitted an official college transcript, check WebAdvisor to confirm that the transfer credits appear on your Camden County College transcript. **You will not be able to register for courses during priority registration, if prerequisites have not been posted to your record.** Call the Records and Registration Office at (856) 227-7200, extension 4200, if you have any questions.

If you do not have Internet access from your home or office, you may go to the cyber cafe, e-village, or open computer labs at any of the three College locations.

## **Important Payment Information**

As a special service, you are able to register during Priority Registration without payment. Please remember that your Spring 2010 tuition bill will be due by **December 7, 2009**. **Payment of your tuition, ON TIME, is critical. Your priority registration course selections may be cancelled if payment or payment arrangements are not made by December 7, 2009.**

## **Financial Aid**

Although the Spring 2010 priority FAFSA filing deadline was September 1, 2009, you still may apply online at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov). Allow 4 to 6 weeks for processing. # Using WebAdvisor, The Online Registration System

**7 days a week\* from the convenience of your home or office**

*\*WebAdvisor is not available from 2 to 6 a.m. daily.*

- Log on to Camden County College's home page at **www.camdencc.edu**
- Click on **Spring 2010 Credit Registration** and then the **WebAdvisor** link. Security is provided by the use of a user I.D. and password.

## What is your I.D./Password?

- Your WebAdvisor ID is unique and provides direct access to your student record. You may use the "What's My ID" feature of WebAdvisor to obtain your WebAdvisor ID.
- Unless you have changed it, your password was initially set as your six-digit date of birth. For example, if you were born on January 3, 1980, your password would be 010380. You will be prompted to change your password for security purposes, the first time you log in. Make note of your password.

## Sign on to Your College-Issued Email Account!

Your CCC e-mail address has a new format:

**FirstName.LastName+last 3 digits of your Colleague ID@students.camdencc.edu**

For example, if your name is John Doe and your Colleague ID is 5551212, then your new e-mail address is John.Doe212@students.camdencc.edu.

Since this new e-mail account will become the College's official means of communicating with students, you must check this mailbox regularly. You **will be able to forward** e-mails from this mailbox to an already existing account that you may have (Yahoo, Hotmail, Comcast, etc.)

**New Students:** After registering you will receive your account by noon the following business day.

**Returning Students:** Your accounts will be in place as you return.
