### IMPORTANT PAYMENT INFORMATION

As a special service, you are able to register today without payment. Please remember that your Spring 2010 tuition bill will be due on **December 7, 2009**. After you register online, you should select the "My account summary by term" feature of WebAdvisor and print a copy of your Spring 2010 charges. If you do not receive a bill by November 23<sup>rd</sup>, yet you have early registered, please contact the Business office at 227-7200, extension 4312. **Payment of your tuition, ON TIME, is critical. Your early registration course selections may be cancelled if payment is not received by December 7, 2009.** More importantly you will have lost a guaranteed seat in course selections that may close out early. If you do not plan to attend your classes, you must officially drop those classes by the refund deadlines or you will be liable for the tuition and fees.

#### Payment Options

Upon receipt of your bill, you may want to consider a number of payment options. We accept cash, check, money order, VISA, MasterCard, Discover and approved financial aid. For your convenience you may pay online with a credit card using WebAdvisor. Refer to the "Spring 2010 Credit Schedule of Classes" or the College's web site for more information or telephone the Business Office at 227-7200 extension 4312.

#### Financial Aid

**FAFSA Priority Filing Deadline September 1, 2009. You may file online TODAY at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov).**

You are encouraged to check the status of your financial aid file online via Web Advisor ([www.camdencc.edu](http://www.camdencc.edu)). You must have confirmation of your financial aid by the payment due date in order to use those funds toward your payment. **If your file is completed after October 1 you should expect to pay your bill from your own resources.** You may be eligible for reimbursement of your payment, should you later receive a financial aid award. Financial Aid refunds will begin being issued at the end of March.

#### Course Changes

A \$25 schedule adjustment fee will be assessed should you make changes after January 19, 2010 (for 15-week session). You may need an adviser's approval to add courses.

#### Refund Policy for the Fifteen-Week Session\*

100% Refund	Official drops through Tuesday, January 19, 2010
50% Refund	Official drops through Tuesday, February 2, 2010
0% Refund	Withdrawals after Tuesday, February 2, 2010

#### Drop Policy

Payment is due at the time of registration (except during priority registration periods). If at anytime your balance exceeds 50% of your charges, **your entire schedule may be cancelled – not just the most recent transaction.** On the other hand, do not expect this policy to absolve you of financial liability. Students' classes are "held" for a variety of reasons. When you register for classes you are agreeing to purchase a seat in each class you select, and you are responsible for payment of the tuition and fee charges. Should you choose not to begin the classes for which you have registered, **you must officially drop** those classes according to the scheduled deadlines to avoid being charged. Failure to attend a class does not constitute an official drop, and you will be held responsible for the associated charges

## Spring 2010 Fees/Charges for Credit Courses

### Course Charges:

- Tuition – per credit (**\$93** in-county; **\$97** out-of-county; **\$167** international)
- General Service Fee – **\$25** per credit
- Course Fee – varies per course

### Insurance Fee:

- **\$3.00** per semester

### Facility Fee

- **\$2.00** per credit

**To avoid late fees and installment plan fees, it is recommended that you pay 100% of your balance at the time of registration.**

### Late Registration/Schedule Adjustment Fee:

- **\$25.00** Charged per transaction for registration or course additions that occur on the first day of the term/session or thereafter.

### Installment Plan Fees:

- **\$10.00** Two-payment installment plan fee
- **\$25.00** Three-payment installment plan fee
- **\$35.00** Late payment on installment plan – charged per month

### Late Payment Fee:

- **\$35.00** Charged per month when no installment plan contract is submitted and balance is not paid in full by start of the semester or when contracted installment payment is late.

### NSF Fee:

- **\$35.00** Charged when checks are returned for **non-sufficient funds**.

### Official Transcript Fee:

- **\$ 5.00** Complete request form, pay fee at the Business Office, then submit form to the Registration Office.

***Please take note that all tuition and fee schedules presented are current at the time of printing of this document. However, they are subject to change without prior notice.***

### Out-of-County Chargeback Information:

All New Jersey residents who attend a county college outside the county of their legal residence are required to complete the necessary chargeback authorization forms at the beginning of the semester. This process enables eligible students to be assessed in-county charges. Failure to request chargeback may result in your being charged a higher tuition rate.
