CAREER PROGRAMS (AAS) prepare students for entry-level employment in an occupation which requires both theoretical knowledge and practical skills.

TRANSFER PROGRAMS (AA, AS, AFA) are designed primarily to enable students to enter the third year of baccalaureate study at four-year colleges and universities.

CERTIFICATE PROGRAMS these certificates fall into two categories: Certificates of Achievement (CA) and Academic Certificates (CT). Academic Certificates include between 30 and 36 credits inclusive of six credits in general education

CERTIFICATE OF ACHIEVEMENT PROGRAMS have less than 30 credits or more than 36 credits and do not have a general education requirement.
