## **DENTAL ASSISTING CLUB**

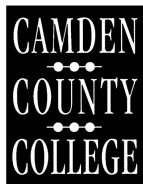

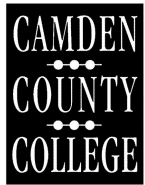
