

# **Summary of Actions**

Camden County College Board of Trustees Meeting of June 2, 2017 Roosevelt Hall, Room 102 Blackwood, New Jersey

# **Grants, Contracts, and Gifts**

The Board authorized the College to apply for the following grants:

- \$25,000 from the Wells Fargo Foundation to support expanding the New Student Orientation and Introduction to College programs.
- \$200,000 from the New Jersey Department of Labor and Workforce Development for the New Jersey Builders Utilization Initiative for Labor Diversity (NJBUILD) Grant Program.
- \$20,000 from the New Jersey Department of Labor and Workforce Development for the County Apprenticeship Coordinator Grant Program.
- \$10,000 from Santander Bank to provide Financial Literacy instruction to students in the Gateway to College Program.
- \$210,000 from the Camden County Workforce Development Board and the County of Camden for the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act Out-of-School Youth Services grant.

The Board authorized the College to accept the following:

• \$1,736,893 from the New Jersey Department of Children and Families for the Child Assault Prevention (CAP) Grant Program (the Board further authorized the award of contracts for CAP subcontracting agencies in the anticipated amount of \$1,110,172).

The Board authorized the College to apply for and accept the following:

• \$750,312 for the Carl D. Perkins Career and Technical Education Improvement Grant Award.

The Board authorized the termination of the following programs:

The Board authorized a sabbatical leave request for Professor Elisabeth Bass during the fall 2017 semester.

# **Executive Committee Action**

#### **Outside Counsel**

The Board (under a County shared services award) awarded a contract for special, conflicts, and labor counsel to Brown & Connery for a term of June 2017 to June 30, 2018.

The Board authorized an agreement with the Camden City School District for implementation of the Gateway to College Program for the term September 2017 to June 30, 2018.

# **Shared Services Agreement: Camden County Technical School (Technical Institute)**

The Board authorized a shared services agreement with the Camden County Technical School for services associated with the consolidation of the Technical Institute within the College under the same terms for the period July 1, 2017 to June 30, 2018.

#### **Shared Services Agreement: Camden County Technical School (Renewal of Programs)**

The Board authorized a shared services agreement with the Camden County Technical School for services associated with the Law & Public Safety, Dual Credit, Senior Option, and 21<sup>st</sup> Century Community Learning Centers Program for the 2017 – 2018 academic year.

#### **Brookfield Academy**

The Board authorized a facilities use and lease agreement renewal with Brookfield Academy for the period July 1, 2017 to June 30, 2018.

#### Young Adolescents Learning Experience (YALE) School

The Board authorized a new agreement with the Young Adolescents Learning Experience (YALE) School for the S9P Program for the period September 1, 2017 to June 30, 2018..

# **Cooper University Health Care**

The Board authorized the College to renew the existing Affiliation Agreement with Cooper University Health Care to operate the Family Medicine primary care practice at the Blackwood Campus and to incorporate the amended terms since the original agreement regarding Polk Hall for a period of the initial two year renewal.

# Safety Matters, Inc.

The Board awarded a publicly advertised RFP fair and open contract to Safety Matters, Inc. for webbased online awareness training in the anticipated amount of \$41,300 for the period July 1, 2017 to June 30, 2019.

# Cengage Learning, Inc.

The Board awarded a non-fair and open contract to Cengage Learning, Inc. to provide the College with online training courses through the Continuing Education Department in the anticipated amount of \$30,000 for the period June 5, 2017 to May 31, 2019.

#### MTS Software Solutions, Inc.

The Board supplemented the award made as a result of the bid process and award in 2011, and as necessary, awarded and authorized a non-fair and open contract to MTS Software Solutions, Inc. to provide additional document imaging system software support with supplement/maintenance, Application Enabler software, on-site service and additional PDI licensing to that already purchased, on an as-needed basis in the anticipated amount of \$100,000.00 during the period July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2019.

#### **Emergency Operations Plan**

The Board adopted an Emergency Operations Plan in compliance with N.J.S.A. 18A:3B-19 and authorized appropriate submissions and updating of the Emergency Operations Plan.

# **Quarterly Financial Report**

The Board authorized the acceptance of the financial report for the third quarter of fiscal year 2017, ending March 31, 2017.

#### **Bid/Contract Recommendations**

Motor Coach Transportation

The Board awarded the bid contract for motor coach transportation to Sheppard Bus Service in the anticipated aggregate amount of \$46,700 during the period of July 1, 2017 to June 30, 2018.

Grounds Supplies, Landscaping/Turf Care Materials, Grounds Lawn Equipment, Parts & Repairs The Board awarded the bid contracts for grounds supplies, landscaping/turf care materials, grounds lawn equipment, parts and repairs to Garden State Bobcat, Inc., SiteOne Landscape Supply, LLC, Turf Equipment and Supply Co., Inc. in the anticipated amount of \$35,000 on an as-needed basis with terms commencing on August 1, 2017 to July 31, 2018, and rejected all other bids.

#### Building Materials, Equipment, Supplies & Tools

The Board awarded a bid contract to Comcast Business Communications, LLC for internet and intercampus connectivity services in the amount of \$272,829.60 with terms commencing on July 1, 2017 to June 30, 2020 with an optional two-year renewal contract.

The Board authorized participation in an Educational Cooperative Pricing System agreement, member participation, time and material/maintenance bid enrollment with the Educational Services Commission of Morris County with terms commencing on June 2, 2017 through March 31, 2018.

# Engineering Assessment Services of the HVAC Systems in Halpern and Taft Halls

The Board authorized the College to contract for a proposal for Engineering Assessment Services of the HVAC Systems in Kevin G. Halpern Hall and Taft Hall with Concord Engineering (pursuant to the publicly awarded County of Camden Pool of Qualified Professionals for Architects and Engineering Services) in the anticipated amount of up to \$83,500 with deducts and additional commissioning services per hourly rates as identified in the proposal.
