## **Communication Plan**

<u>Town Halls</u>: Updates will either be included in regularly scheduled town halls or special town halls will be scheduled for this purpose.

<u>General Meetings</u>: Updates will be provided in the fall and spring semesters.

<u>Senior Leadership Team</u>: Executive Director of Institutional Effectiveness & Planning will provide periodic updates on the self-study to the Senior Leadership Team at least once per semester.

<u>Unit Meetings</u>: Updates will be provided to faculty units, administrative units, and staff via their respective members of the Senior Leadership Team.

<u>Student Meetings</u>: Updates will be provided by the member of the Senior Leadership Team responsible for liaising with Student Life.

<u>Board of Trustees Meetings</u>: Updates will be provided to Board members during the regularly scheduled meetings.

<u>Panel Discussion/Roundtable</u>: Arrange for periodic meetings of the Strategic Planning Steering Committee at which the discussion is focused on linkages and connections and setting agendas for moving forward.

<u>Digital</u>: Major announcements will be distributed through the email list to all faculty, students, staff and administrators.
