Dear Parent/Guardian:

We are delighted that your son/daughter is interested in participating in the Camden County Technical High School 21st Century Learning Center Community program. This program is a partnership between the High School and Camden County College. This credit program provides high school students with the opportunity to receive college credit for courses they are taking through the after-school program through CCTS for **FREE**. Upon graduation, students may choose to come to Camden County College or transfer their college credits to a four-year college or university. However, it should be understood that no college, including Camden County College, can absolutely guarantee the transferability of its credits to another institution. **Transferability is ultimately up to each institution from which the student is seeking credit and any questions should be directed to that institution.**

In order to register, the student should:

- Complete the minor application and registration form. Please include the student's social security number, student's signature and parent or guardian signature. Once this form has been processed, the college will issue the student a College ID number.
- Students must have had passing grades at the high school level to participate. Students who have failed a course at the high school level will not be considered.

Once completed, the digital minor application/registration form will be automatically returned to me. The form needs to be completed and returned by Monday, February 6, 2023. Space is limited, as only 20 seats are available for this course.

The psychology class will begin the week of February 6. This course will be offered after school at CCTS. Instruction on how to sign on to the CCC student portal will be provided once a complete registration/application form has been received.

Three (3) Camden County College credits will be awarded upon successful completion of this course. Grades will be posted upon the conclusion of the high school year. Student's grades can be found by signing on to the college website at www.camdencc.edu and clicking the MY CCC portal tab. Transcripts are available through our registrar's office after July 15, 2023. There is a \$10 fee for each transcript request. Please include the student's college ID number on all correspondence.
