

Are you planning to take or retake the Math Placement Test?



To improve your math skills before you test or retest, you can use EdReady. EdReady is a *free* online tool that assesses your math level and provides you with customized learning materials. This program is self-paced. It can take several weeks to complete the program, based on your current math skills and the amount of time you spend working in EdReady.

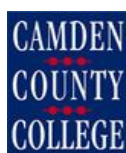
To get started in EdReady, go to: <https://edready.org/getStarted>

- 1) Under New User, select “**Sign Up**”, and fill out your information
- 2) On the next screen, select the goal: “**Prepare for Common Placement Exams**”
- 3) Scroll down to the bottom of the page, and under “**General Math Placement Test Prep**”, select “Start Diagnostic”

Complete the diagnostic, which will set up a customized online “course” for you. This course will include basic math, algebra and higher level math topics. Do the topics in order, and complete as many as you can. See reverse side for a list of math topics.

Do not use a calculator because calculators cannot be used on the placement test.
