

## CARES Grant Reporting

On May 28, 2020 Camden County College signed and returned to the U.S. Department of Education a Certification and Agreement that Camden County College has used, or intends to use, no less than 50 percent of the funds received under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students. As requirement of accepting these fund the institution is required to report to the public within 30 days of receipt of the funds and every 45days thereafter.

## **Awarding Parameters**

**Awarding parameters Spring 2020 and Summer 2020:** Camden County College required students to complete an online application asking them to identify areas of need that they had experienced due to the campus disruption related to COVID-19. Once the application was received it was screen in accordance to the Department of Education guidance provided at the time of review. Student who met all the parameters were awarded \$1000 if they were enrolled more than 6 credits in the Spring 2020 semesters or \$500 if they were enrolled in 1-5 credits. The same set of awarding parameters were used for the first two rounds of CARES grant awarding with the exception that students registered for Summer were also considered.

**Awarding parameters Fall 2020:** Students were still required to complete the online application that indicated that they were still encountering hardships based on the disruption of campus activities caused by COVID-19. Applications were screened to ensure eligibility based on programmatic requirements provided by the Department of Education. Students who met the requirements and were enrolled at least 6 credits were awarded \$700 for the term. The change in the awarding amount allowed us to be able to meet the significant demand for the funding for the semester and award more students funding.
