Rutgers, The State University of New Jersey, School of Nursing, has collaborated with Camden County College in Blackwood, NJ to provide an opportunity to obtain a Bachelor of Science Degree in Nursing after completing an Associate's Degree in Science - Pre-Nursing Track. Students applying to the program must have either an Associates of Science degree or sixty (60) undergraduate pre-requisite credits from Camden County College. This program offers:

- Admission into the School of Nursing upper division academic nursing program at Rutgers School of Nursing – Newark & New Brunswick
- The opportunity to complete all coursework on the Camden County College - Blackwood campus
- Clinical experiences in the southern New Jersey area

### Admission Criteria:

- Preferred GPA of 3.3 (Full Consideration given to applicants with a GPA of 3.0 or above)
- Preferred grade of "B" or higher in the following courses: A&P I and II, Chemistry I and II, Microbiology, and English Composition I and II
- Must enroll and complete the CCC CPR 1 credit course, HPE-181 Basic Life Support (BLS), during your last spring semester.
- May only have one science, Microbiology or Chemistry II, incomplete at the time of application.
- Completion of the application form
- Unofficial copy of all college transcripts
- Well-written, brief essay addressing the topic/question asked on the online application form

### Admissions Process:

- All application and admissions information for the Summer 2024 cohort will be made available online on or around November 15, 2023

### Program Requirements:

This is a full-time program that requires a considerable commitment for class, clinical attendance and preparation.
