This application is for matriculated CCC students interested in receiving summer financial aid. To be considered you must complete a 2022-23 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at www.studentaid.gov/fafsa; which has a deadline of June 30, 2023.

Grant Eligibility:

To receive a Pell Grant award during the summer semester a student enrolled in less than 6 credit hours must have remaining eligibility for the 2022-23 aid year. If enrolled in 6 or more credit hours, a student may qualify for additional year round Pell Grant funds over the 2022-22 yearly limits. *All payments of Pell reduce a student's remaining lifetime Pell limit.
